Based on IMO SOLAS Agreement, KODCO has concluded a distributor contract with watercourse department in each country, including UKHO, in order to provide nautical charts and publications required for every ship to set out on scheduled sailing and therefore has established an international supply chain true to its name.

Small Correction

KODCO only supplies the latest nautical charts through small corrections and also provides tracing papers for more convenient and accurate small corrections in a ship.

Ship's Auto Supply System

On the basis of Regulation 20 of Chapter 5 of SOLAS Convention, every ship is required to have the latest nautical charts/guides, list of lights, Notice to Mariners, and tide table and all nautical publications required for sailing shall be of the latest version. Ship's Auto Supply System operates for making nautical publications owned by ships into the latest version and KODCO manages hundreds of ships of major shipping enterprises in and outside of Korea at present and the number of such continues to increase.

Mandatory Carriage of ECDIS

IMO approved a revision of SOLAS Convention that obliged the installation of ECDIS at the 86th MSC General Assembly hosted in June 2009.

In accordance with the revised SOLAS Convention, every liner, oil tanker, and freighter started to install ECDIS according to a sequential schedule from July 2012.

For a smooth supply of electronic navigational charts according to the obliged use of ECDIS in ship, executed in 2012, we only supply official electronic navigational charts, including those issued by the Korea Hydrographic and Oceanographic Administration and those accredited by UKHO.


